Away from me, you bloodthirsty men! **20** They speak of you with evil intent; your adversaries misuse your name. **21** Do I not hate those who hate you, O Lord, and abhor those who rise up against you? **22** I have nothing but hatred for them; I count them my enemies. **23** Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. **24** See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

1 Kings 19:11-13
